PACKAGING TECH IV \$22.12/hr

Pre-Hire Requirements

- ✓ High School Diploma or a GED
- ✓ Safety Screen

Typical Duties Include:

- ✓ Perform basic equipment care
- ✓ Operate/support basic mobile equipment
- ✓ Support bulk loading and sugar screening
- ✓ Operate industrial packaging lines and support consumer packaging line
- ✓ Perform sanitation and dust abatement duties
- ✓ Perform and document food safety and food quality checks
- ✓ Provide palletizer/wrapper and sugar screening support

Skills/Knowledge Required to Promote to PKG Tech III:

- ✓ Sanitation and product disposition
- ✓ Food safety/food quality
- ✓ Consumer and industrial packaging line support
- ✓ Maintenance and equipment care
- ✓ Yard support and rail switch operation
- ✓ Bulk loading support and operations
- ✓ Product flow and control systems
- ✓ Warehouse operations and product loading

- ✓ Perform sanitation duties as required
- ✓ Operate packaging equipment
- ✓ Perform quality rounds
- ✓ Assist stations as needed

- ✓ Control the flow of all sugar
- ✓ Assist shipping and logistics when needed
- ✓ Instruct others in the operation of the lines
- ✓ Inspect all incoming paper and packaging products
- ✓ Coordinate the activities of other packaging employees
- ✓ Perform various lab tests and analysis
